

Middle Ages Project

Students are to create a presentation on a topic from the Middle Ages (400-1500 AD). Topics may cover any topics related to the Middle Ages located anywhere in the Eastern Hemisphere. The topics of the report must be approved with Mrs. Stocking prior to beginning, with no more than 2 students doing the same topic.

Students must fill out the Project Proposal paperwork with ideas listed to gain approval. Students will then write their resources they found on the Project proposal paper. A minimum of 5 websites and 2 books are required.

Students then type a 1 page, single-spaced report on the topic of their choosing. This report is then used to create the oral presentation to the class. This typed report gets turned in at the time of the presentation.

Oral Presentation:

The Oral Presentation will be given in class. Students will sign up for a time on February 20, 22, 23. The Oral presentation must be at least 3 minutes in length. The presentation must include either a slideshow or a poster board.

Visual Aide (optional)

Students may choose have a visual aide. This visual aide would be something in addition to a poster board or power point presentation. A visual aide is extra credit.

Examples include:

*Doing a report on medieval clothing with a visual aide of paper dolls wearing medieval clothing.

*Doing a report on Trebuchets and creating a popsicle stick version of a trebuchet.
