Safety Items

- **Safe Walking Routes** found on website *Check to see if there are any issues that need to be addressed*
- **Safe Technology/Digital Citizenship** NetSmartz used in the past, digital format this year? *Look at sending out information through ParentLink*
- **District Filtering System** District filtering system in place. Kim gets a report from the district of students who are trying to access inappropriate websites and works with parents. Does the council want someone from the Tech Department to come and address the council about filtering concerns? The council has heard the presentation and doesn't feel it is necessary at this time.
- **Safety Drills** postponed due to the pandemic *Drill practice within the individual classrooms rather than school-wide for now.*
- Safety guidelines at the school for COVID
 - o Masks worn in the building, taken off at recess
 - o Separated desks, dividers new dividers being purchased
 - Discussed not being able to see through the current dividers
 - Not extending beyond the desk for those that sit side-by-side (3rd grade desks)
 - o Students wash hands, use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day
 - o High touch areas sanitized multiple times a day by custodial staff
 - Lunchroom and Gym separated, fewer students at each table, X's on the floor, tables sanitized between each grade level
 - Sanitizing mist used throughout the day in multiple areas
 - Staff required to leave at 4:00pm every day for extra sanitization
