Safe Walking Routes Presentation - SRO Jason Crowther & Alex Judd

Due to a situation at Provo High School, our SRO was not able to attend the meeting. Officer Crowther called during the meeting and rescheduled for next month.

2020-2021 Amendment - Approximately \$50,000

Infini-D Lab - infinidlearning.com <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=pPyhkHQIj1E>

- K-9 Curriculum is fully automated, just plug and play
- Hardware on a mobile cart - can be used anywhere
- Missions are rigorous and involve everyone in the decision-making process
- Every SEEd (Science) Core Standard/Math Core Standards this year
- Computer Science, Social-Emotional Learning Standards
- Addresses knowledge, skills, and dispositions
- Data analysis component for teachers
 - 1 year - \$2550 setup, \$14.00 per student (625 students = \$8750), maximum of \$8,000 per year
 - 3 years - \$24,000 - 10% = \$21,600
 - Extra lab (recommended) - \$1000

iXL License

1 year - \$5250

3 years - \$14,175

Reading Plus License

1 year - \$7,500

2 years - \$12,980

3 years - \$17,640

Fully funding Infin-D Lab, iXL, Reading Plus for 3 years = \$53,415

Amendment Discussion:

Infini-D Lab – allocate for 3 years of funding

Do we need more than two labs? Brooks at Infini-D recommended two labs based on our school size.

Council felt that the integration of math, science, computer science, and Social-Emotional Learning is really exciting. Having the students participate in “missions” based on the curriculum could be highly engaging, plus it allows for decision-making among the students. Council is excited about having the Infini-D Lab. Amber Maio (teacher rep) is excited that there is more than just science curriculum.

iXL & Reading Plus Licenses – Using the excess money now to fund the licenses for 3 years will allow us to hire assistants for interventions/extensions, which is what our teachers have requested and what our data shows we need.

Doug Garner – Motioned to amend the plan in order to purchase two Infini-D Labs for 3 years, which includes hardware, software, teacher training/support, and purchase a 3-year license for iXL and Reading Plus
