- Crossings require a minimum of 10 students traveling to school 45 min prior and 15 min after.
- Category 1 Crossing is required to be operated by an adult. A category 1 crossing exist if it utilizes yellow flashing lights for slower speeds. If light signals are utilized, and if the crossing is located at a roundabout.

#### **Safe Routes Plan, page 1**

- Safe Route Plans are needed to be eligible for federal funding to make infrastructure changes.

#### **Safe Routes Plan, page 2**

- Safe Routes planning process.
- Each School District traffic safety committee must submit the Safe Routes Plan no later than April 1st to be implemented at the beginning of the following school year.
- School Community Councils are required to review and update the Safe Routes Plan at least once per year.

#### **Safe Routes Plan, page 4**

- How to identify the required members of the School Community Council.

#### **Safe Routes Plan, Page 5**

- Inventory needs and concerns of each route.
- Routes should be identified within a 1 to 2-mile radius of the school.
- It is important to establish the safest routes for students in lieu of the shortest routes.

- If loading zones are insufficient for safety schools can stagger departure and arrival times.
