# Goals & Funding for 2022-2023 - \$87, 851.51

80% of Kindergarten through 6th-Grade students will make typical or above progress on the Acadience Pathways of Progress End of the Year assessment.

Students in 3rd through 6th-Grade will increase their math scores by 3% as measured by the end of year RISE test data.

Students in 4th through 6th-Grade will increase their science scores by 5% as measured by the end of year RISE test data.

Para-educators will provide remediation and extensions for our Kindergarten through 6th-grade students. Additional funds will be used to support Goals 1 and 2 in the following ways (depending on need):

- Increase the number of para-educators for remediation and extension.
- Purchase curriculum, support materials/supplies, manipulatives for Reading, Math, or Science.
- Cover costs of reading, math, and science computer software programs
- Purchase headphones for computer software programs.

### Discussion about Goals:

The council agrees that Reading, Math and Science should continue to be our focus. They agree that goals should be set for Acadience and RISE for next year. We would like to see all grade levels reach our goals. We almost did that last year, but we have a few grade levels that did not make the goals. Kim will present the Middle of the Year Acadience data at next month's meeting.

# Discussion about Funding:

LETRS training for upper grades – Should the council use Trustland funding for LETRS training? Is it possible? Are upper grade teachers interested in LETRS training?

Kim will invite Megan Clark to present to the council next month, since she is the para-educator's supervisor and over interventions.
