2023-2024 Trustland Plan - Approved by School Board with Rubric Feedback

- Goals
 - 80% of Kindergarten through 6th-Grade students will make typical or above progress on the Acadience Pathways of Progress End of the Year assessment.
 - Students in 3rd through 6th-Grade will increase their math scores by 3% as measured by the end of year RISE test data.
 - Students in 4th through 6th-Grade will increase their science scores by 5% as measured by the end of year RISE test data.

Funding

Para-educators will provide remediation and extensions for Kindergarten through 6th-grade students.

Additional funds will be used to support Goals 1 and 2 in the following ways (depending on need):

- Increase the number of para-educators for remediation and extension.
- Purchase curriculum, support materials/supplies, manipulatives for Reading, Math, Science or STEM
- Cover costs of reading, math, and science computer software programs
- Purchase headphones for computer software programs.
