Barbie wondered if there was a Spanish speaker to help in Kindergarten and throughout the school. Kim explained that two Kindergarten teachers and a Kindergarten assistant speak Spanish. There is also a Spanish speaker in the office on Monday-Friday from 8:00-11:30am. She also goes into the classrooms and works with our Spanish-speaking students who are new to the country to help with additional support. We also have a SpEd teacher, a librarian, a head custodian, and a few instructional assistants who also speak Spanish and help with translation when needed. We also have a Language Line service available to us.

# **Safety & Security**

Perry shared the Community Council's work on the Safe Routes last year. He gave an update on his conversations with the city. We were able to get lines painted on 1500 West. Perry will create a GoogleDoc and send it out so that the council can start gathering concerns/ideas to submit to the city. Barbie is willing to do any research that is needed or gather "stories" from the community. She is also willing to contact Travis Hoban about the council's suggestions.

Kim will find out when the ideas need to be submitted to the district.

# Goals & Funding for 2023-2024

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is 80% of Kindergarten through 6th-Grade students will make typical or above progress on the Acadience Pathways of Progress (POP) End of the Year (EOY) assessment. The Acadience assessment helps teachers determine how students are performing on important reading skills. These critical reading skills include phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, and comprehension.

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is that students in 3rd through 6th-Grade will increase their math scores by 3%, and students in 4th through 6th-Grade will increase their science scores by 5% as measured by the end of year SAGE/RISE test data.

Funding Total: \$93,839.72

Para-educators will provide remediation and extensions for our Kindergarten through 6th-grade students
