January’s meeting will likely be canceled unless we find that we cannot wait until February 6 to discuss items.

Goals & Funding for 2023-2024

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is 80% of Kindergarten through 6th-Grade students will make typical or above progress on the Acadience Pathways of Progress (POP) End of the Year (EOY) assessment. The Acadience assessment helps teachers determine how students are performing on important reading skills. These critical reading skills include phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, and comprehension.

Our goal for the 2023-2024 school year is that students in 3rd through 6th-Grade will increase their math scores by 3%, and students in 4th through 6th-Grade will increase their science scores by 5% as measured by the end of year SAGE/RISE test data.

Funding Total: \$93,839.72

Use of Funds: Para-educators will provide remediation and extensions for our Kindergarten through 6th-grade students
